Property Values Grow in Top Oil & Gas Producing Counties



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Americans are reaping numerous economic benefits, including higher property values, in many of the nation's largest oil and natural gas producing counties.

WASHINGTON COUNTY, PA

Washington County, which produced 46,168,246 cubic feet of gas in January 2015, saw median home values rise 4.4% over the past year.

TARRANT COUNTY, TX

Property values in the state's largest natural gas producing county rose by nearly \$6.8 billion – a 5.3% increase – from 2013 to 2014.

JOHNSON COUNTY, TX

Home values in the third largest natural gas producing county in the state have increased 10.5% in the past year.

WELD COUNTY, CO

In Colorado's top oil producing county the median home value rose 15.3% in the past year.

One of the state's largest oil producing counties "has seen the total assessed value of its properties quadruple since 2007, to \$73.7 million."
