

# Harrison County Fact Sheet



Harrison County has **487** Utica Shale wells in various stages of activity by **nine** oil and gas operators.

- ✓ 66 permitted
- ✓ 27 being drilled
- ✓ 24 drilled
- ✓ 370 producing



The highest level of production to date took place in 2015. The county produced 638,677 barrels of oil and 127.6 billion cubic feet of natural gas from 2011 to 2017.
