Noble County has **227** Utica Shale wells in various stages of activity by 10 oil and gas operators.

- ✓ 43 permitted
- ✓ 14 being drilled
- ✓ 4 drilled
- ✓ 166 producing



The highest level of production to date took place in 2016. The county produced 8.2 million barrels of oil and 362.9 billion cubic feet of natural gas from 2011 to 2017.
